We celebrate Ash Wednesday on February 17th. This will be the last Lenten Season celebrated in our existing church as we move to our new facility. We approach Lent 2010 with a mix of sadness and loss, but also, a sense of anticipation and excitement.

Holy Family Parish is experiencing a period of transition that presents a golden opportunity to reposition ourselves as a vibrant, growing faith community. Our Lenten theme for 2010 will be a "Pathway to the Cross" that will offer reflection on:

Feb 21st- 1st Sunday of Lent – Preparing the Soil
Feb 28th- 2nd Sunday of Lent – Serving- We help one another
Mar 7th- 3rd Sunday of Lent – Inviting-We inspire one another
Mar 14th- 4th Sunday of Lent – Thanking- We pray with each other
Mar 21st- 5th Sunday of Lent - Giving- We enjoy each other
Mar 28th- 6th Sunday of Lent – We enter Jerusalem with Jesus

Preparation, Serving, Inviting, Thanking and Giving are attributes that promote development of an "Engaged Parish" with a vibrant and growing spirit. An attractive Lenten Altar frontal will note our progress as we make our Lenten "Pathway to the Cross."
